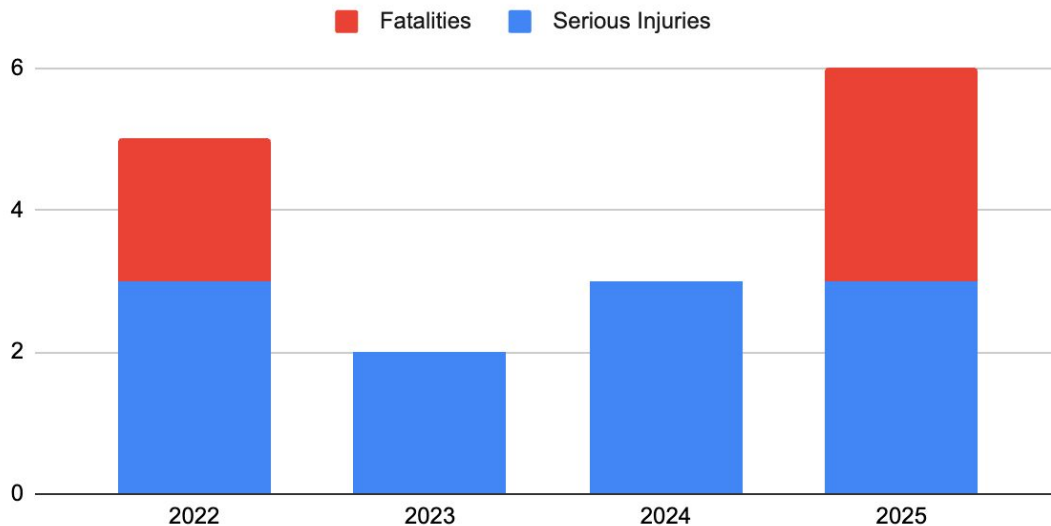


Evergreen Highway Safety Analysis TIP Project 0741

Evergreen Highway Serious Injuries & Fatalities 2022-2025

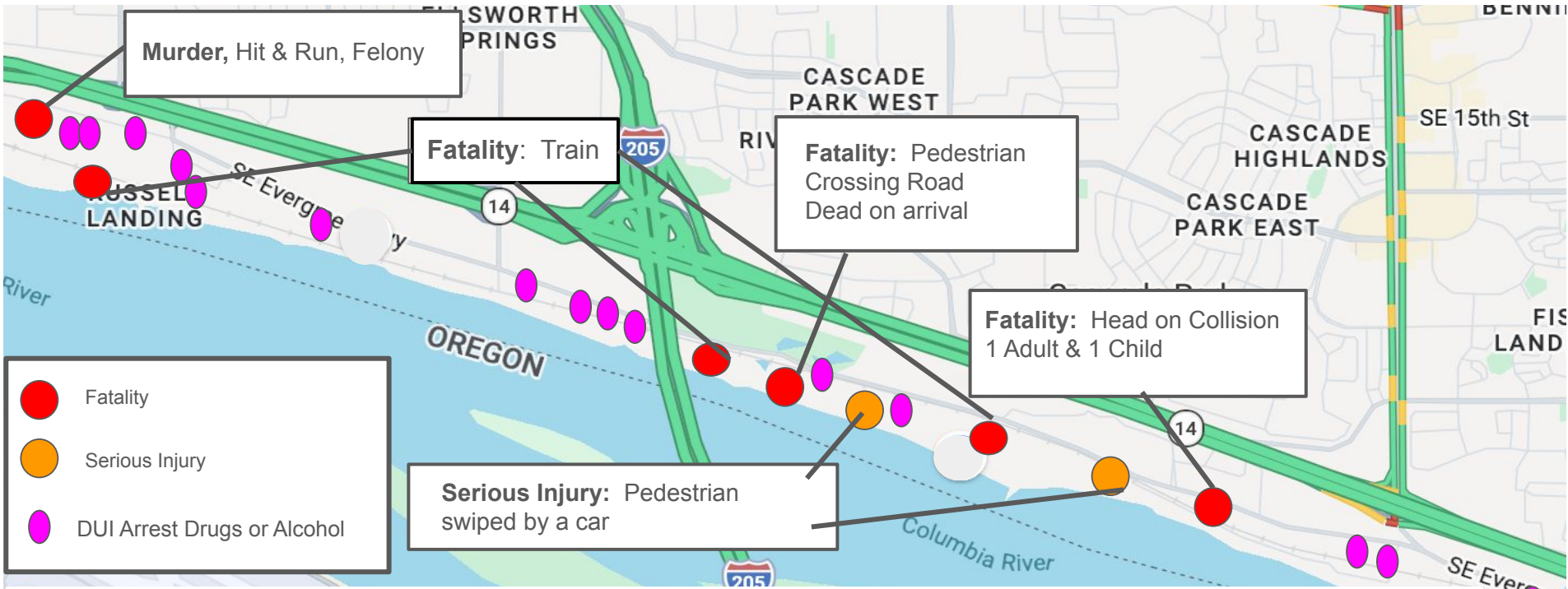

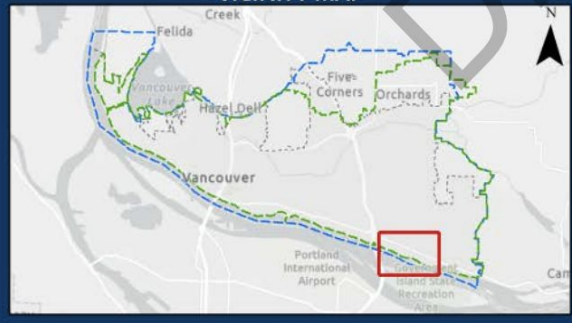
